What should I know ...

- . Name and locate counties and cities of the United Kingdom
- Facts about a region of the United Kingdom
- Describe and understand key aspects of physical geography and human geography, including: types of settlement and land use etc.
- Use a wider range of maps (including digital), atlases and globes
- Use maps and diagrams from a range of publications e.g. holiday brochures, leaflets, town plans
- Make and use simple route maps
- Recognise patterns on maps and begin to explain what they show Label maps with titles to show their

I will be taught facts on

- Locate the world's countries, using maps to focus on Europe (including the location of Russia)
- Identify the position of latitude, longitude, Equator, Northern Hemisphere
- Learn about a region in a European country
- Children will explore similarities and differences between the region being studied and regions of the U.K. with which they might be more familiar
- Be aware of its broader geographical context, such as the country and continent in which it is located
- A wider range of maps (including digital), atlases and globes to locate countries and features studied
- Use maps and diagrams from a range of publications e.g. holiday brochures, leaflets, town plans
- Use spreadsheets, tables and charts to collect and display geographical data
- Make use of geography in the news online reports and websites

Key Questions ...

- What do the children know already about this region? What would they like to know or find out?
- Where is the region located? How far away is this region?
- What is the physical geography like e.g. climate, landscape, rivers, mountains etc? What distinctive features does the region have?
- What is the human geography like e.g. settlement size, transport, tourist attractions, economic activity and trade links?
- How does location, climate etc. have a bearing on economic activity in the region?
- What are the similarities and differences between this region and the region of the UK that has been explored previously in Year Three?
- What are the lives of children in this region like? How are their lives similar to ours? What would it be like to live in this place?
